International Conference Scholarship

The Association of Fundraising Professionals Capital Area Chapter (AFP-CAC) is inviting qualified fundraising professionals to apply for a scholarship that covers the registration fee PLUS \$500 towards travel and expenses. The scholarship is awarded by the AFP Foundation and the Chapter, to attend the 55th Annual International Conference on Fundraising to be held in New Orleans, LA from April 15 – April 17, 2018. The conference offers numerous workshops and lectures to develop fundraising skills, obtain valuable information, and network with colleagues from all over the world.

Eligible applicants must:

- Be employed as a fundraising professional or, if the President / Executive Director, must devote a substantial amount of time to fundraising;
- Be a member of the AFP-CAC in good standing, not a Membership Scholarship recipient in the year of application;
- Active participant in AFP-CAC activities;
- Obtained approval of the organization's President, Executive Director, or Board Executive Committee member;
- **NOT** have attended a previous AFP International Conference on Fundraising as a registered participant;
- Agree to complete an on-line Evaluation Form about his or her experience at the International Conference; and
- Agree to write an article/make a presentation about their experience for the Chapter to use. Recipient will also be asked to present brief comments about their experience at a Chapter meeting.

The selected Chamberlain Scholarship recipient is responsible for planning their own travel arrangements and registering themselves for the conference (approximately \$10) on a special Chamberlain registration form that they will receive from AFP International.
